Who can attend?

You can! Any recent year 12 graduate (having graduated within the past 3 years), if you are looking for support to enrol in further study or training or to find a job – then you are eligible to access this free service.

What is Link and Launch?

Link and Launch assists school graduates who want to secure work, study or training. Link and Launch Officers work one-on-one with clients to help them navigate all the options and access support where needed.

Who is eligible?

Eligibility includes having completed Year 12, within the last three years, with or without having achieved a QCE.

What does it cost?

Link and Launch is funded by the Queensland Government.

There is no cost to you.

Where do I go?

Your local Link and Launch Officer is located at Townsville State High School; however, appointments can be arranged at an alternate location as required eg. local library, Maccas, a cafe or your even at your former school.

How long does it go for?

There is no time limit or schedule to follow. We can meet as little or as often as you would like or need.
